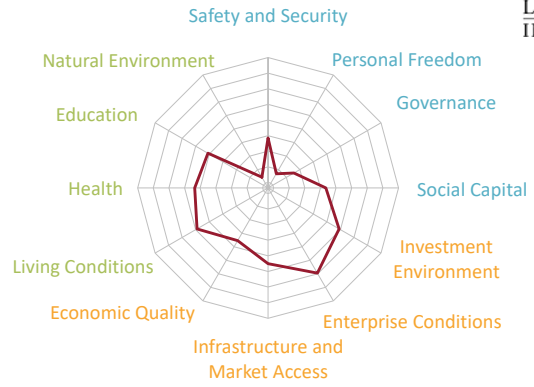
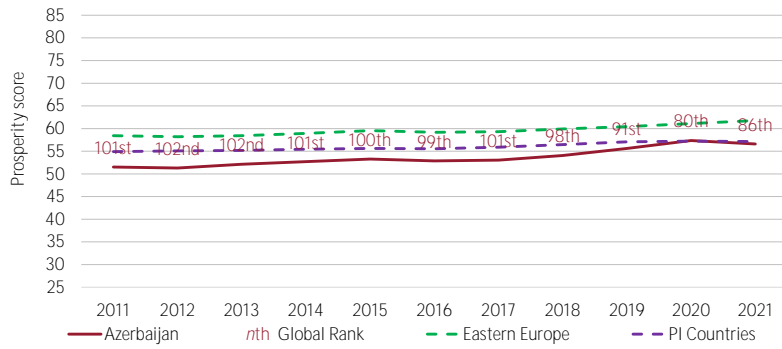














Azerbaijan: Prosperity score 56.6 (86th)
