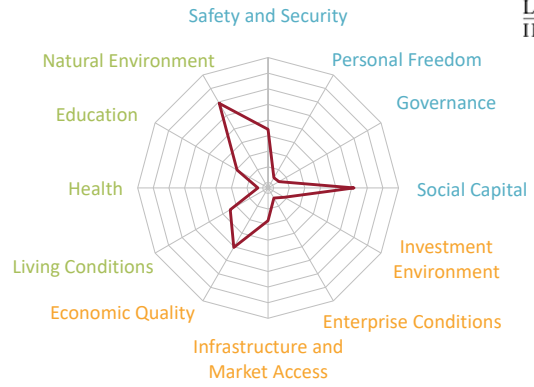
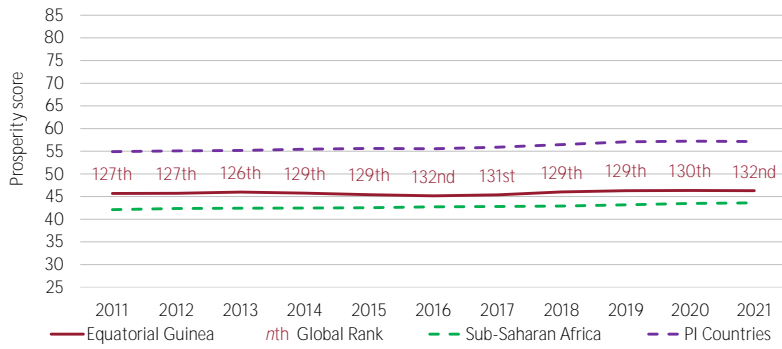




Equatorial Guinea: Prosperity score 46.3 (132nd)
