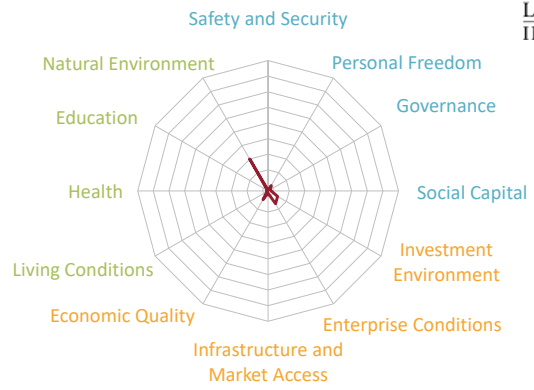
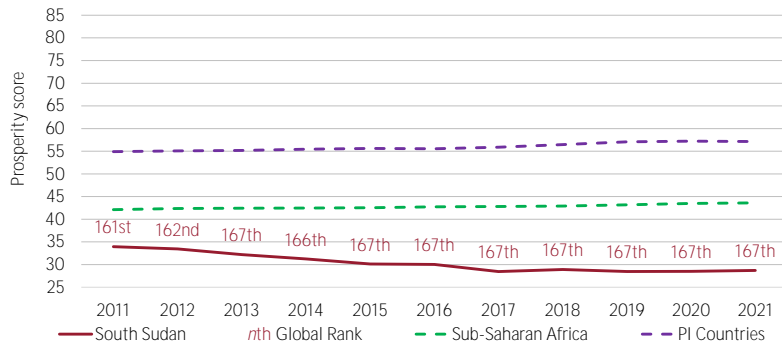

Prosperity over time























































































