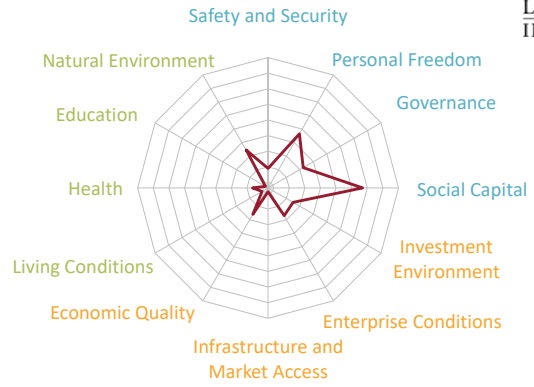
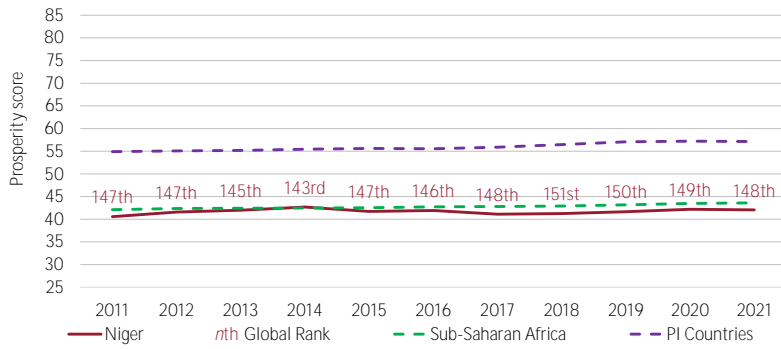




Niger: Prosperity score 42.1 (148th)
