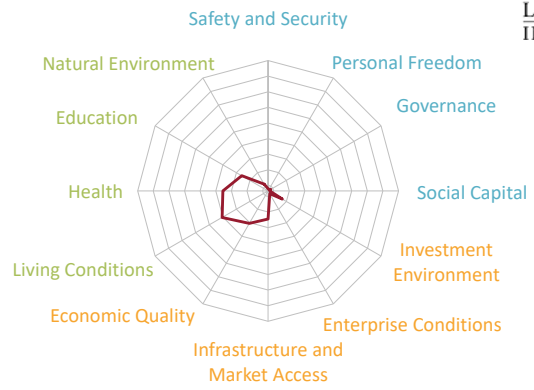
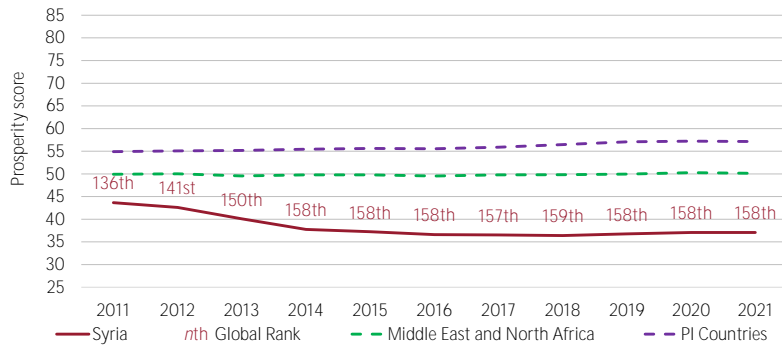


Syria: Prosperity score 37.1 (158th)
