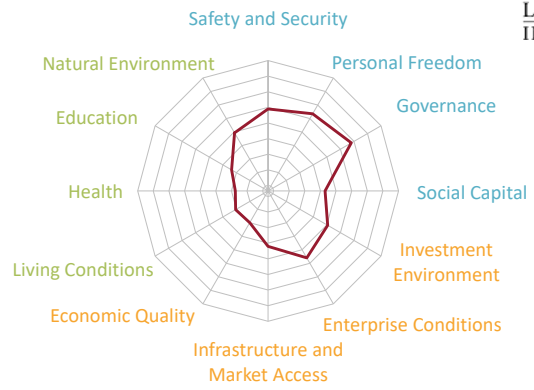
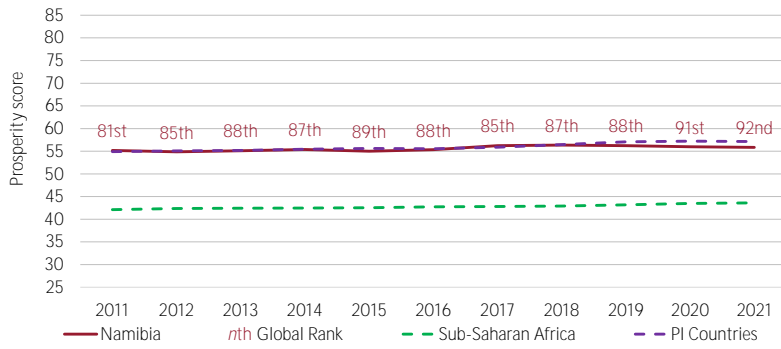


Namibia: Prosperity score 55.9 (92nd)
