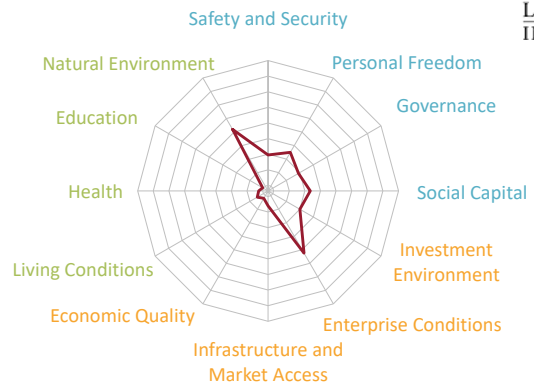
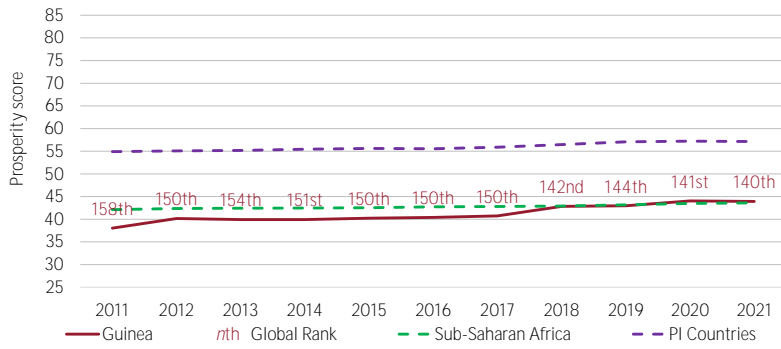


Guinea: Prosperity score 43.9 (140th)
